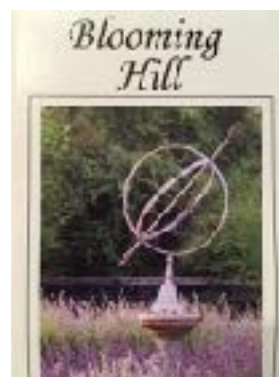
UMW Guide
